

EXTENSION OF TIME FOR HOLDING ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING AND CIRCULATION AND LODGMENT OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR COMPANIES AFFECTED BY THE MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER



The Companies Commission of Malaysia has on 1 June 2021 issued an updated Practice Directive 8/2021 (“PD 8/2021”), to allow extension of time for companies to hold Annual General Meeting (“AGM”) and, to circulate and lodge financial statements.

Under the PD 8/2021, a 90-day extension of time is granted for the holding of AGM and, the circulation and lodgment of financial statements. The 90 days extension period will be effective respectively from the date the AGM was supposed to be held and, the date the financial statements were supposed to be circulated / lodged.

The extension of time is granted upon the application (in a prescribed format to the Registrar by 31 July 2021 through e-mail to eotmco3@ssm.com.my) by affected companies with financial year end **AFTER 31 October 2020 to 31 January 2021**.
